# The 2017 Thomas Fire: Impacts & Lessons Learned



## Field Tour: Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, 8am – 4pm

Planned stops include:

- Impacts to Ventura as the fire raced into the city
- Perspectives from residents impacted by the fire
- Post-fire mudslides in Montecito

## Tour Description

This day-long field tour will examine the 2017 Thomas Fire, which is the largest wildfire in California history and which was followed by mudslides that killed 21 people. Join fire experts, residents, and policy-makers as they discuss the fire, the impacts, and lessons learned from this event. The Thomas Fire burned ~282,000 acres in Ventura and Santa Barbara Counties, destroying over 1000 structures, and causing numerous deaths and injuries in the ensuing mudslides. The day will end with a chance for further discussion and networking at a no-host reception at a local establishment.
