# Fire and forest restoration in the eastern Sierra Nevada

The morning will be devoted to presentations by guest speakers and will be followed by an optional trip to local field sites in the afternoon. Presentations and discussions will focus on the ecology and management of eastern Sierra Nevada forest ecosystems, and related topics.

- Forest and fuels management (Brandon Collins, USFS PSW and UC Berkeley)
- Smoke in the Sierra Nevada (Donald Schweizer, UC Merced and USFS)
- Fire and forest restoration under the new Inyo Forest Plan (Marc Meyer, USFS)

The afternoon field trip will focus on the ecology and management of eastern Sierra forest ecosystems, with an emphasis on the ecological role of fire. Field trip participants will need to bring:

- Long pants and sturdy boots required; hard hat recommended
